Nomination papers must be hand delivered to the Returning Officer or his appointed staff at **The Main Reception, The Council House, Wiltshire Council, Bourne Hill, Salisbury, Wiltshire, SP1 3UZ.** Between 10am and 4pm on any working day from and including Thursday 20 May 2021 but not later than 4pm on Thursday 27 May 2021. Please go to main reception and ask for Electoral Services.
4. Please make an appointment to submit your nomination papers by using our online booking system: <https://ilforms.wiltshire.gov.uk/BookingsElectionCandidateSlot/Index> or by phoning Electoral Services on 0300 456 0112.
5. If contested, the poll will take place on Thursday 24 June 2021.
6. Applications to register to vote must reach the relevant Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on Tuesday 8 June 2021. Applications can be made online: [www.gov.uk/register-to-vote](http://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote).
7. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the relevant Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on Wednesday 9 June 2021.
8. Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the relevant Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on Wednesday 16 June 2021.
9. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of disability or for work/service reasons must reach the relevant Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on Thursday 24 June 2021. The disability must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday 16 June 2021. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Wednesday 16 June 2021.
